- 1 Sims-Williams here presents a new pre-Sassanian Middle Persian inscription on a silver bowl providing an attempt at partial translation. The text mentions two officers probably connected with the Arsacid autonomous vassal kingdom of Persis. What is interesting though is the comparison with a previously published similar inscription by Skjærvø, dated to the 1st century BC and mentioning a member of the local ruling dynasty. The parallel study of both texts provides useful information about the local Pahlavi script and its evolution.
