Notes for authors

We want to thank you for contributing to our journal.

Your article should be written using a font size 11 (Times New Roman), with simple left-justified paragraphs, titles in bold, no underlining and with continuous footnotes numbering for the whole text.

We also ask you to add the following elements:

- the **title**: it should be short and concise in order to fully represent the content of your article; if the title is too long, then it is advisable to split it in a short title with a sub-title.

- **authors**: we consider to be authors all of the persons who have actively taken part in the research work and its design; it is better not to mention more than 6 authors; the order of the author list is alphabetical; persons who have made only small contributions to the research should be thanked in the Acknowledgment section of the article.

- **key-words**: these are important to inform about the content of the article; they will be mentioned in the online version of the article; several types of key-words can be chosen: geographical, names of persons or institutions, themes; we would prefer you to choose these key-words to enable your article to be classified and searched in the most relevant way.

- **abstract**: it can be written in French, English or another language relevant to the article.

- **bibliography**: you should indicate only references which are the most relevant to your article so that it is not too long; if you can, please also send us a Zotero version of your bibliography.
