Our recommendations for online publication

Submitted or accepted version – Annual volume

According to the French law [loi pour une République numérique](#), you may diffuse the submitted or accepted version of your manuscript as soon as it is published on the platform of your choice. This does not apply to the publisher's published version, for which the delay is one year.

Publisher's version – Annual volume

We kindly ask our authors to wait one year before publishing the printed PDFs of their papers online on the platform of their choice.

We recommend the public and institutional portal HAL, which has the Gallia Prehistory collection, which we regularly update: notices for each paper are created with each new publication, while the associated PDFs are added after one year. We encourage you to avoid putting your PDFs online on private portals (such as Academia or Research Gate) as this would mean that you would lose your rights: instead, put a link to the files uploaded on HAL.

Supplement

We kindly ask our authors to respect the three-year delay, negotiated between our journal, Persée and CNRS Éditions.
